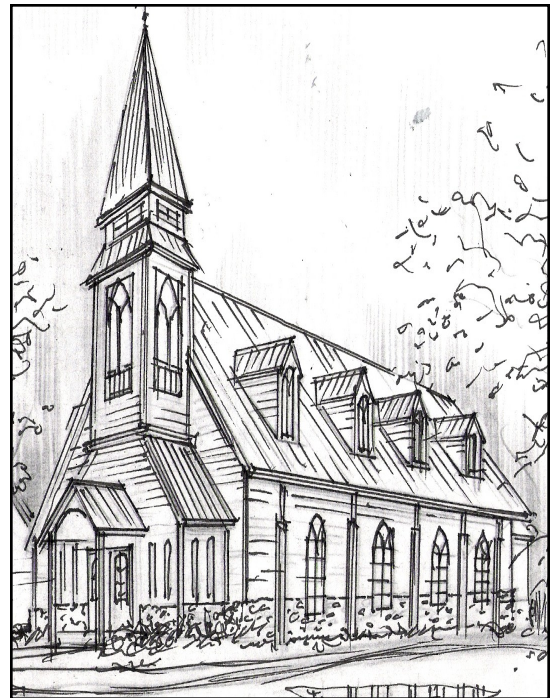

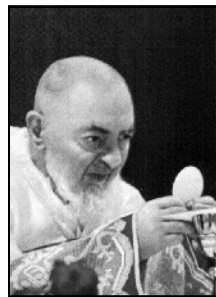
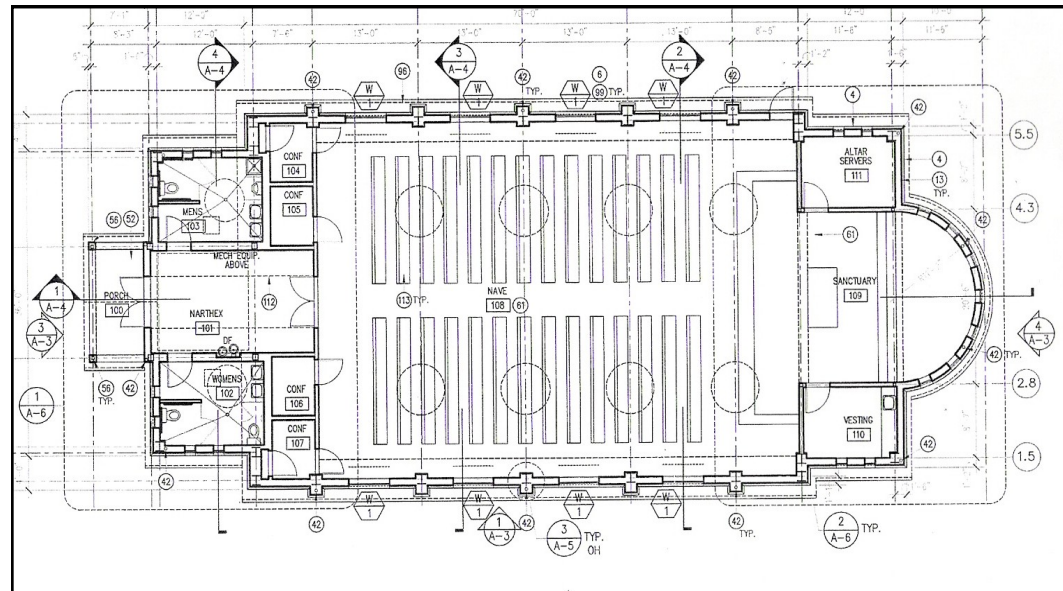
Please join in building a beautiful house for Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. Your intentions will be remembered by our students at every Mass in the Chapel.

In addition, there will be a side altar dedicated to the Holy Family and a side altar dedicated to St. Pio.
